

# Home Tasks

These activities focus on this terms topic 'Seaside Pirates'.

I would like your children to complete as many of these activities as possible at home - some of them may require some adult supervision or help. I would love you to take some pictures of your children completing these tasks and email them to me.

<p>Sing seaside songs or rhymes, e.g.- 'A sailor went to sea, sea, sea' 'Once I caught a fish alive' 'Row, row, row your boat' 'Baby Shark'</p>	<p>Some animals that live under the sea have fins to help them move around. Others have legs to move around with. Can you think of some sea creatures that have fins and some that have legs? You could try drawing a sea creature.</p>	<p>Create your own Pirate Treasure Chest using a used egg box.  See below for instructions.</p>	<p>Phonics activity: There are lots of fish under the sea. Can you think of 3 other words that end with 'sh'? Now, can you think of 3 words that start with 'sh'? Shark, Shell, Ship</p>

Have a look around your house or garden and find 2 things that you think will float and 2 things that you think will sink. Ask a grown up to help you test if you are right.</p>

# Treasure Island Pizza



## Ingredients

Pizza dough mix (or homemade pizza dough)

Grated cheese

Tomato puree

Green pepper (sliced)

Black olives

Tomato

Sweetcorn

## Equipment

Oven – set to 200°C/gas mark 5

Chopping board

Knife

Spoon

## Method

1. Make the dough for the pizza bases.
2. Stretch out a handful of dough to make a pizza base. It doesn't need to be circular, it's a map! Repeat for a second base.
3. Using the back of the spoon, spread tomato puree on the pizza bases.
4. Add the cheese.
5. Cut the pepper in half and then into slices. Use the slices of pepper to make palm trees on the islands.
6. Cut the tomato into quarters and slice into strips. Use the slices to make an 'X', for 'X marks the spot'.
7. Cut the olives in half lengthways and slice into strips. Use the strips of olives to make the path to the tomato 'X'.
8. Sprinkle sweetcorn on one side of the pizza to make a beach.

Other ingredients you may wish to add:

- Mini meatballs – for rocks.
- Slices of sausage instead of olives.
- Pineapple to make another beach.

# Fruity Pirate Ship

All aboard! Create your own delicious fruity pirate ship.

## Ingredients

- 1 banana
  - 1 handful of strawberries and raspberries
  - 2 tbsp crème fraîche
  - 1 orange
  - 1 apple
- (You can change the fruit used to suit taste.)

## Equipment

- Knife/chopping board
- Tablespoon
- Plate
- 2 cocktail sticks
- Paper and pen (to make the sails and flags)

## Method

1. Peel your banana and carefully slice it in half lengthways.
2. Lay your banana halves together on a plate.
3. Fill the gap between the 2 halves with the crème fraîche.
4. Place your strawberries and raspberries on top of the crème fraîche. These are your pirate crew!
5. Cut your orange and apple into slices and place these around the outside of your boat to make oars.
6. Cut out paper sails and decorate them with some skull and crossbones.
7. Carefully slide the sails onto each cocktail stick and push the sticks into the banana to make the ship's sails.
8. Enjoy your tasty fruity pirate ship!
